Iain is a sought-after watercolor instructor and juror and has been published in numerous books and periodicals. He has a 3 DVD set of instructional videos and is planning to shoot another set available in 2022. In 2021 his first book on painting; *En Plein Air- Light and Color*, was published.

Iain maintains a studio in Opelika, Alabama, and in addition to gallery work, is an Architectural Illustrator with an international clientele and teaches watercolor and design drawing at Auburn University where he received his degree in Architecture.

Artist's Statement

I am trained as an architect and, as such, approach painting design with a very similar sensibility. I feel that I need to communicate the vernacular of place in a way that is deeply personal to me. I embrace a dialogue between the real and imagined- seeking a way to allow myself to express my personal feeling of being in a certain setting rather than being confined by the reality of it. That ebb and flow, the back and forth, are what I find important and are my motivation for all my work.

ELIGIBILITY

- Open to all artists, ages 18 and over.**
Fees: TWS members \$55, for 1-3 paintings: Member dues must be current /paid for 2023.
Non-TWS members \$65, for 1 painting.
- Entries must be original
- Entries must have been painted within the last two years.**
- Work completed in a workshop or under supervision is ineligible. Work using photographs other than the artist's own is not considered original. Source material must be original and not derived from published images. Paintings submitted, but not exactly the same as entered images, will be disqualified.
- Artwork will be reviewed by TWS screening committee to insure adherence to prospectus.
- Entries cannot be work that has been published or accepted into any other national exhibition.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

- Paintings must be water media on 100% rag or cotton paper.**
- No collage will be accepted.
- Minimum image size is 10"x14".
- Outside frame dimension cannot exceed 42" in any direction.**
- Paintings must be matted and framed under plexi-glass & ready to hang. The frame must be simple, without ornamentation, sturdy enough to support art without buckling. No saw tooth hangers. Mats must be white or light-colored neutral tones (a colored liner is acceptable).
- Paintings must be for sale.** The artist will receive 60%, University of the Incarnate Word will receive 20% and TWS 20%.
- All paintings will be handled with care; neither TWS, nor the University of the Incarnate Word, nor Scobey's Moving & Storage will be held responsible for loss or damage of work submitted. Insurance coverage is the responsibility of the individual artist.
- NOTE: If your work is accepted into this exhibition it will not count toward SIGNATURE MEMBERSHIP unless you are a current dues paying member of TWS.**

- Limited to three images per artist
- All fees are **non refundable**.
- Use JPEG files only. Minimum size: 1200x1800 pixels (4x6). 300 dpi required for catalog publication purposes.
- Images will be used in the catalog. Color rendition must be accurate.
- Crop images to exclude frames or mats.
- Images must represent the painting exactly.
- Each image must have an entry number, artist's last name, and title to coincide with the entry form. Name images with first four letters of last name, # of painting, and name of painting.
i.e: Smit1Lilies.jpg/Smit2WoodGate.jpg etc.

Note: jpg will be automatically placed on the file when it is saved.

CD ENTRIES:

- Send Entry Form, Fee Check, and CD to Computer Systems, Inc., P.O. Box 171241, San Antonio, Texas 78217.
- Place entry number, artist's last name, and titles on the top side of the CD with a permanent marker. Ensure that each image is individually identified. Follow instructions for images listed in #'s 1 through 7 above. Use one CD. CD's will not be returned.

ACCEPTED PAINTINGS

- Accepted artists and instructions for shipping paintings will be posted on the TWS website on the date listed in the calendar.

- Only one painting per artist will be accepted for the exhibition.
- Work may be hand delivered (\$30 handling fee) or shipped (\$50 handling fee). Shipping/handling fees and insurance are the responsibility of the artist.

Note: Acceptance is a commitment to show. "No-shows" will be disqualified from entering for two years.
